Every year, the month of January is dedicated to raising awareness of Crime Stoppers' successes and motivating more Texans to get involved. In the past year, Crime Stoppers programs across Texas have received over 82,000 anonymous tips leading to the arrest of over 3,800 suspects, \$1.3 million in rewards paid, and \$1.3 million worth of narcotics seized by law enforcement responding to tips.

It's Application Time!

The Request for Application (RFA) is posted online and is ready for you to review and start applying for the Crime Stoppers Assistance Fund.

The deadline is February 11th at 5:00 pm CST.

Project Period

Projects must begin on or after 09/01/2021 and may not exceed a 12-month project period.

Funding Levels

The minimum request is \$2,500.

The maximum request is:

- * Up to \$10,000 for certified Crime Stoppers organizations.
- * Up to \$15,000 for certified Crime Stoppers organizations that support or seek to initiate both an adult (standard) crime stoppers tip line/program and a campus tip line/program.
- * Crime Stoppers organizations preselected and approved by Texas Crime Stoppers to host either the annual Crime Stoppers conference or the annual Campus Crime Stoppers Conference may apply for up to \$50,000 to fund reasonable and actual costs associated with hosting the conference.

2020 Texas Best Awards deadline is March 1, 2021!

The Texas Best Awards highlight Crime Stoppers organizations from around the state that stand out in various categories. The categories are divided into three segments; the first being productivity or community impact, the second being the individual excellence awards, and the third is the media award categories.

Certified Texas Crime Stoppers organizations in good standing are encouraged to participate in this year's award competition recognizing the extraordinary efforts, commitment, and dedication to their mission of solving and preventing crime in Texas from January 1 (of the previous calendar year) through December 31 (of the previous calendar year). To ensure "good standing," all organizations must have submitted all required reporting documents to be considered for an award.

Use one entry form per nomination and label each supporting item with the program name and competition category. All nominations must be made with the required attachments listed on the entry form.
