

The prestigious award is presented annually to a Citizen Police Academy (CPA) coordinator who is deemed to have contributed the most to the development of the CPA program during the year.

Everyone likes a pat on the back when they do a good job, and law enforcement officers are no exception. If you receive service from law enforcement in the Texas multi-county areas of Montgomery, Liberty, and San Jacinto counties, or observe law enforcement actions in these geographies that you feel are worthy of a commendation, we would like to hear about it.

As part of Back the Blue, and in conjunction with KSTAR radio and Top Cop Shop, Multi-County Crimes Stoppers will select one officer from among the weekly submitted entries to receive a \$50 gift certificate to the Top Cop Shop, where the chosen officer can purchase equipment to help them in the performance of their job. Half of the gift certificate (\$25) is funded by MCCS, with matching funds (\$25) from the Top Cop Shop. The award announcement will be made on KSTAR radio.
